Executive Summary

Deliverable D6.1 presents a brief overview of the public DOMINOES project website (<http://dominoesproject.eu/>). The document provides a concise description of the content of the DOMINOES website supported by screenshots. The site aims at providing public access to general information about DOMINOES project, such as a list of publications, events, news, etc. The deliverable is part of task 6.1. – Dissemination.

1 Introduction

The DOMINOES project will undertake special efforts to disseminate the project progress and its results to the broad (academic, policy, market practitioner and user) stakeholders. A detailed communication plan will be developed in accordance with an interaction matrix to increase both the interest towards and impact of the project activities.

To increase the interest of the stakeholders towards the project and its progress, the consortium will organize its communication work and related communication events with the objective of (a) informing a broad public via continuous website and social media interaction and (b) involving a selected group of stakeholders to ensure the relevance of the work. To increase the impact of the project results, the consortium teams and all its researchers engaged in the project will work to promote activities of (c) consulting various groups of stakeholders to obtain valuable input (knowledge and competences) and (d) collaborating with stakeholders to define the directions and priorities of the research.

Deliverable D6.1 is a public document that provides a brief overview of the DOMINOES project website. Notably, the webpage went public on the December 11th, 2017 at <http://dominoesproject.eu/>.

The project website is a platform to promote DOMINOES project goals and to communicate to the general public news and general information about the results achieved by the project and its main milestones along the project duration.

The website will be updated continuously by ISEP/DOMINOES team, guaranteeing a timely dissemination of information and project status, as well as appropriate public access for stakeholders.

Throughout this document, the structure of the website and functionalities will be described, providing a full picture of the design and organization of the site. Some final remarks are also provided.

The project Website is a powerful tool for continuous communication measure. It is foreseen to:

- a) Include testimonials and videos for each demonstrator;
- b) Include links to DOMINOES Social Media

2 DOMINOES Website Structure

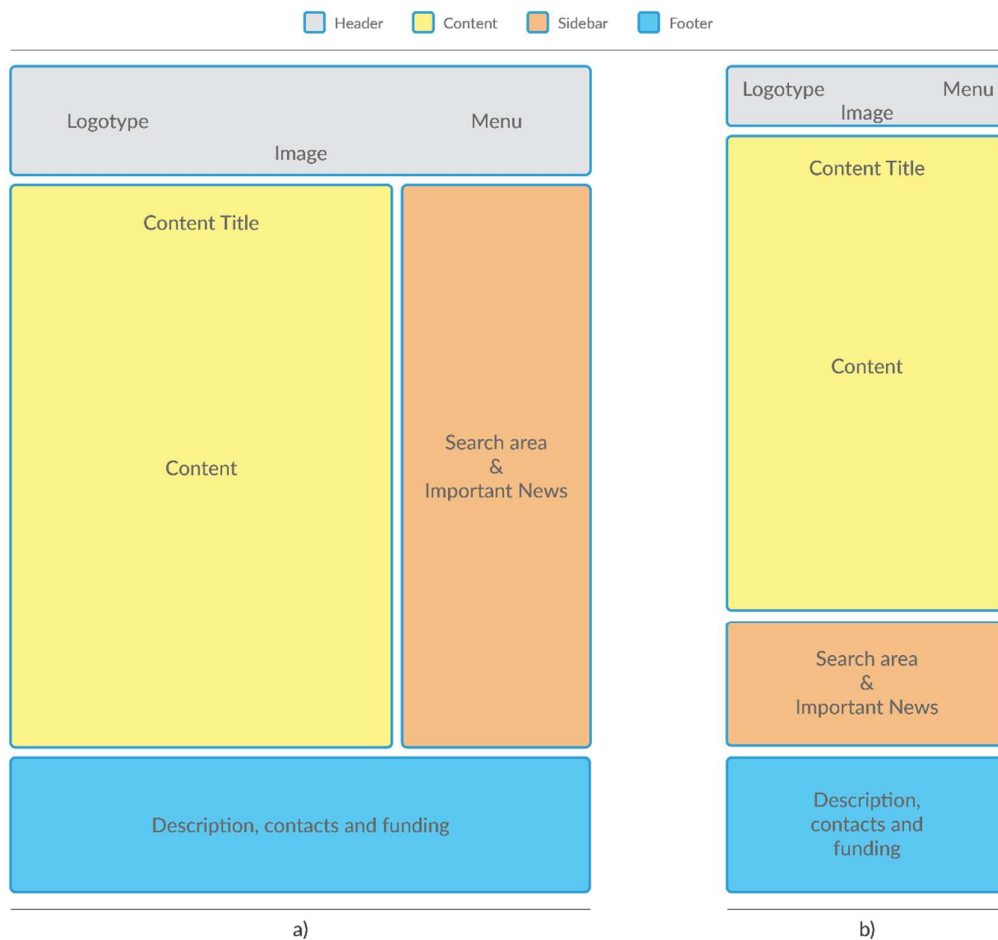


Fig. 1: General layout of the DOMINOES website. a) desktop view. b) mobile view

DOMINOES website was designed to provide friendly access to the public information of the project. Since the website can be accessed through different types of devices such as desktop computers, tablets, and mobile phones, two main layouts for the website were created following the structure from Fig. 1.

For desktop computers, the layout follows the general structure showed in Fig. 1a. The layout includes a header at the top (with general information), a middle section with content and side bar (including search area and news), and a footer with the description, contacts and funding information. In the case of accessing the website using mobile devices, Fig. 1b. shows the layout that the users will see, which differs slightly from the main layout showed in Fig. 1a. Despite those differences, the information that can be found in both layouts is the same and will be described in next subsections.

2.1 Home

The home section of DOMINOES website presents all relevant information regarding the project, namely project logotype, official name (i.e., DOMINOES - SMART DISTRIBUTION GRID: A MARKET-DRIVEN APPROACH FOR THE NEXT GENERATION OF ADVANCED OPERATION MODELS AND SERVICES), funding and actors, purpose and objectives and expected goals.

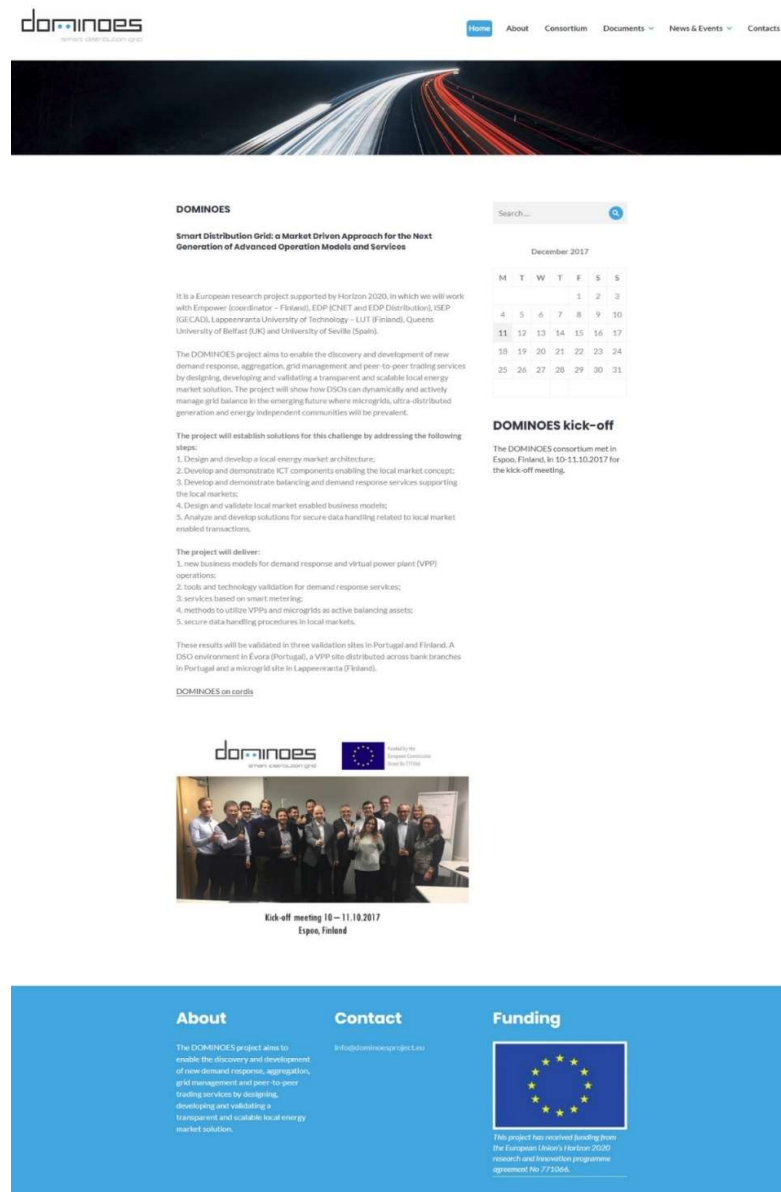


Fig. 2: “Home page” screenshot

Fig. 2 shows the general overview of the home section. As can be seen, this section is the presentation card of the project and provides access to more specific information through the menu on the right-top of the window.

2.2 About

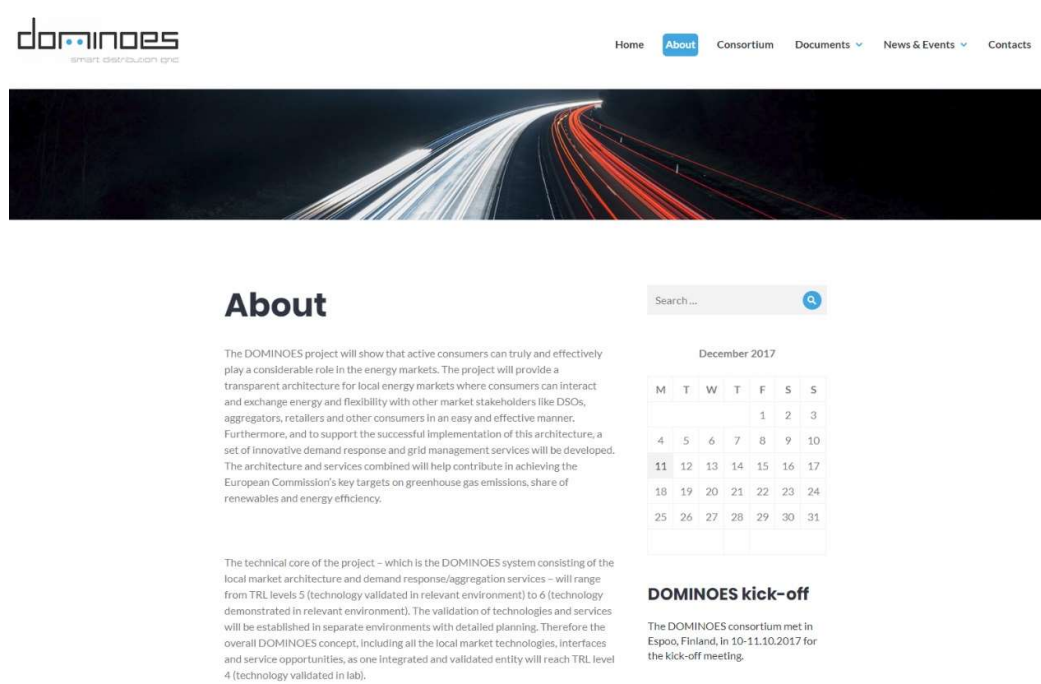


Fig. 3: “About page” screenshot

Fig. 3 shows a screenshot with the content in “About page”. To summarize, as the name indicates, “about section” presents in a concessive manner the purpose and objectives of DOMINOES project. It provides a summary of information such as overview of the project, deadline, funding, context, goals/aim, demonstrator, challenges, WP, solution, expected results, etc. In addition, a schematic figure of the seven work packages the project is divided is included.

2.3 Consortium

The consortium section provides summarized information about the partners developing DOMINOES project. The DOMINOES consortium is composed by eight partners from four European countries, namely Finland, Portugal, Spain, and the UK. The partners can be divided into two diverse groups as follows:

- commercial companies (Empower, EDPD, VPS)

In addition, “Consortium page” includes links to the leading websites from the consortium.

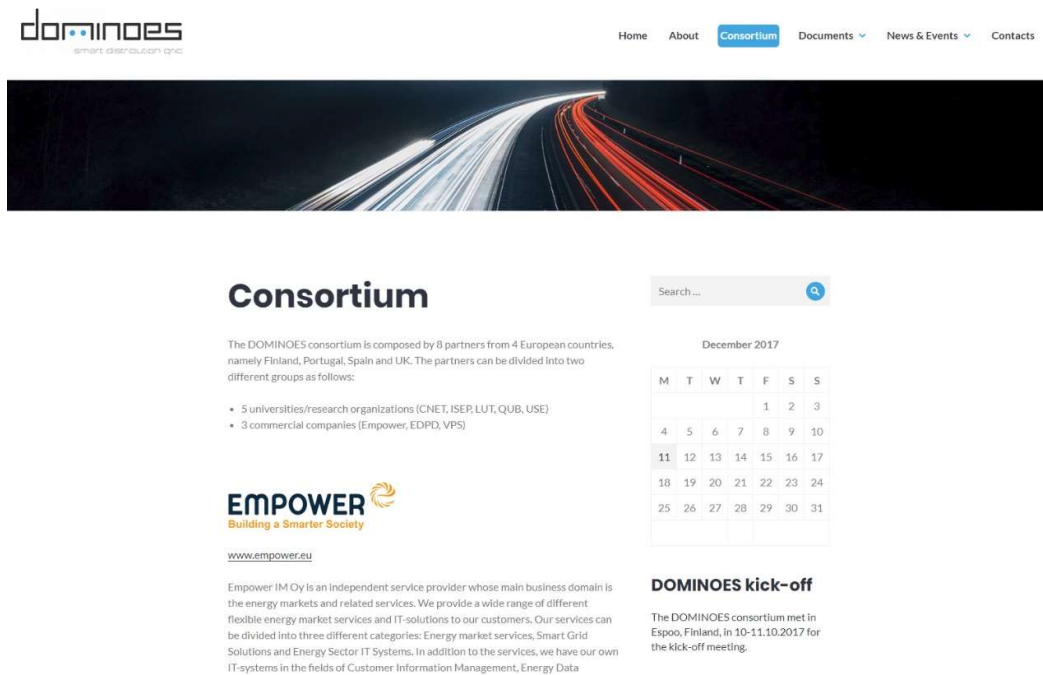


Fig. 4: “Consortium page” screenshot

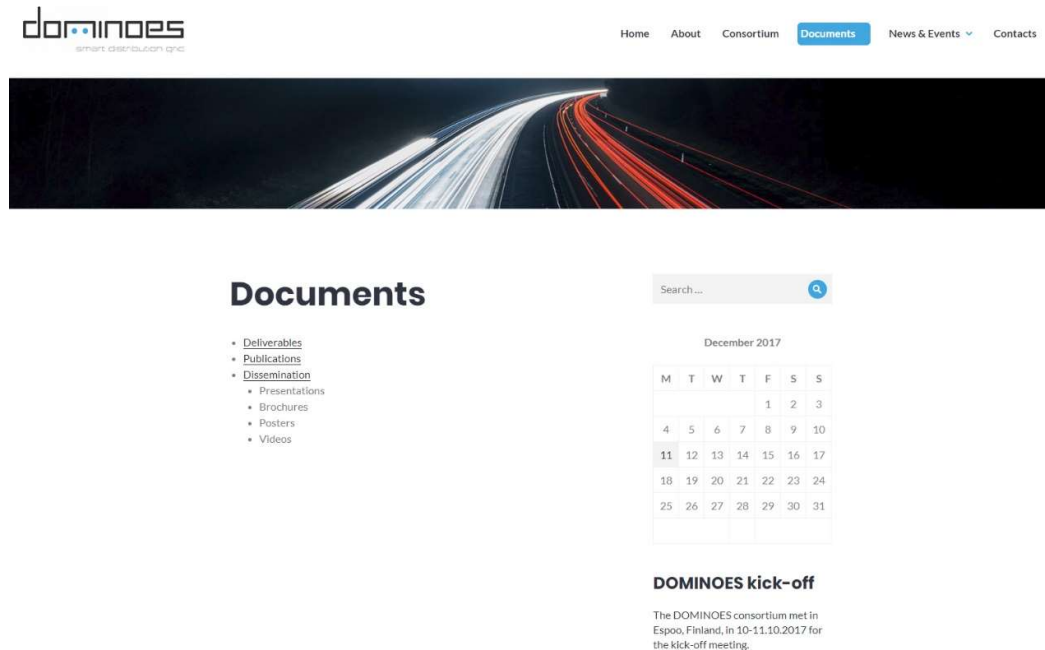


Fig. 5: “Documents page” screenshot

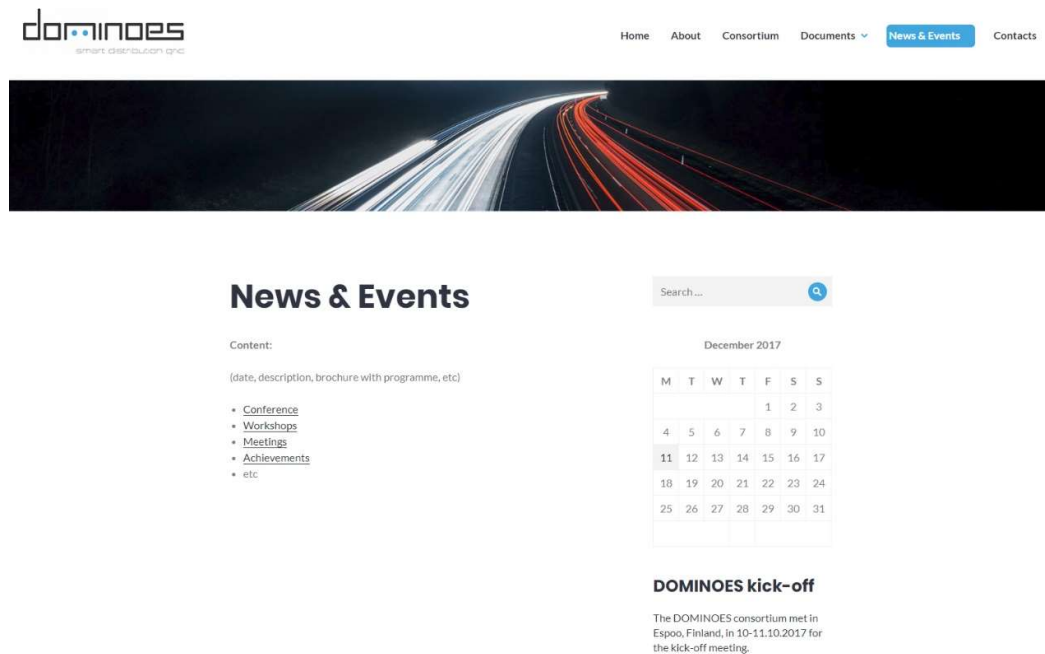


Fig. 6: “News and events page” screenshot

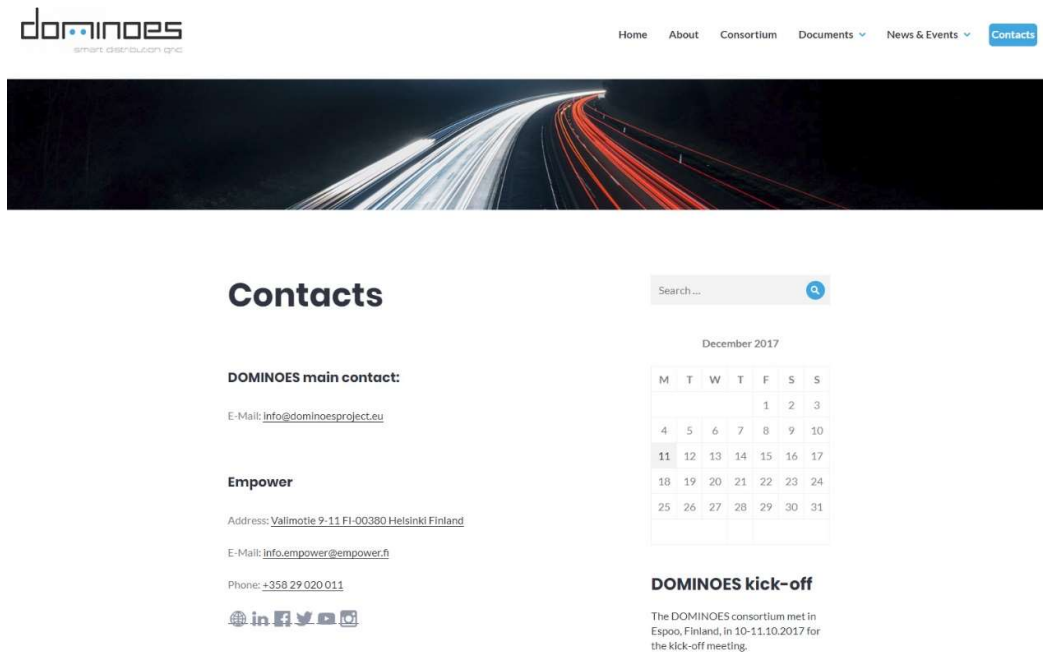


Fig. 7: “Contacts page” screenshot
